Classes:

Pre-Entry (must be received by Sept. 10th)

\$15/class

\$50/division

Post Entry: entries received after Sept. 10th or day of show.

\$25/class

\$65/division

Each competitor who pays an ADS non -member fee, may at any time in the 12 month after the event apply that fee towards and ADS membership. This offer does NOT expire at the end of the calendar year.

Stabling:

\$20/night - includes first bedding. Must provide own stall front. Space is 9'4". Screw eyes may be placed in existing stall walls. \$20 stall deposit (separate check)
